

Seahawk Athletic Code of Conduct



Chief Sealth International High School, Student Athletes are expected to follow and promote the following:

1. **Commitment to Conduct:** Personal conduct (the way we carry ourselves) is a conscious choice. We are committed to conducting ourselves with honor and class by treating our school, visitors and the people that make up the Chief Sealth community with respect and dignity. We all represent Chief Sealth and wish to send a positive message to our classmates and community around us. Appropriate dress determined by the individual coaches will be worn each game day.
2. **Commitment to Team:** Being a part of a team is a privilege. By being given that privilege we commit ourselves to the “team” effort of achieving excellence and success by way of individual sacrifice and outstanding support. No one person stands above the team. All student /athletes will abide by the team rules set in place by the individual coach or Athletic Director.
3. **Commitment to Academics:** First and foremost, our mission at Chief Sealth is toward academic achievement. We will commit ourselves to achieving in the classroom and respecting the learning environment of all students. All student –athletes must have a 2.0 term GPA and have passed at least 5 full classes the previous semester to be eligible for game participation. Regular class attendance is required and student/athletes will complete a “Game Day” card on days of competition.
4. **Commitment to Language:** We are committed to respecting the boundaries of respectful language by speaking at all times in a language that respects the school, family, and community environment.
